Greetings from the Calgary Firearms Centre and Conservation Education Centre for Excellence:

The Calgary Firearms Centre & Conservation Centre for Excellence (CFC) and the Alberta Hunter Education Instructors' Association (AHEIA) are pleased to welcome all shooters to the 2022 shotgun season. We extend a very special welcome to visiting shooters from across Canada participating in the Canadian Trapshooting Championships, being held June 29 - July 3, 2022. We are honoured to be hosting this premier shoot and anticipate an exciting competition! Pre-squadding for the event will be available at presquad.com.

We are very happy to be offering our full slate of competitive shoots this year at the Calgary Firearms Centre. We have come through two long years of cancelled or reduced capacity events due to the ongoing health crisis. However, with the pandemic recovery on the horizon, it is shared experiences such as these that will see people back at the range enjoying the sport that we love, the renewal of friendships, and the camaraderie of being with fellow shooters. Throughout the pandemic, the Calgary Firearms Centre has taken every precaution to keep shooters, staff, and visitors safe. Protocols have been in place since the beginning, and we will continue to abide by the restrictions mandated by Alberta Health. We appreciate your cooperation with regards to the current rules and regulations.

The Calgary Firearms Centre has a long and exciting history offering the clay target sports to local enthusiasts. Just minutes south of Calgary, it has evolved into one of the busiest facilities of its kind in North America. Home to the Women's and Youth Shotgun leagues, trap, skeet, and sporting clays as well as an archery field and archery league, the facility is open year-round to accommodate anyone who wishes to try an activity. Should you wish to participate in a league, you will be coached in skill development in a safe and controlled environment from one of our dedicated and qualified volunteers. The facility is open to the public for shooting, plus we also offer an annual membership. By purchasing a CFC shooting membership, you receive reduced target fees and discounts on various merchandise at the pro shop. You can purchase a membership online through our website, aheia.com, or in person in the clubhouse.

Returning visitors will notice that we have made some improvements to the facility over the past year. In the clubhouse there has been a complete renovation of the women's bathroom, plexiglass shields installed over the kitchen and main counters for staff and guest health safety, a window installed in the kitchen for alternative ordering options, and changes to the north side of the building for people registering for shoots. Outside, a berm has been built along the north, west and east boundaries of the property, adjacent to the sporting clays field, new clay target machines have been installed, and cosmetic improvements undertaken throughout the property. We are excited about the additional improvements we are planning for the buildings and grounds this year, including a large gathering hall attached to the west end of the existing clubhouse.

The Calgary Firearms Centre is owned and operated by the Alberta Hunter Education Instructors' Association, a non-profit organization whose mission is **making wildlife and fish a part of the value system of every Albertan**. This is achieved through a broad spectrum of programs, both online and at our four facilities in Alberta. Whether it be through our online options which include the Alberta Hunter Education Program, Pleasure Craft Operating Training and the Fishing Education Program, or in-person at any of our camps, seminars or classroom locations, we strive to offer outdoor experiences for men, women, and children through our Conservation Education programming. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Prices** All services at the Calgary Firearms Centre are subject to GST. Prices listed in this Program do not include GST. **Target prices are subject to change without notice in the event of an increase in the price of targets to the club.**
- Shells** Reloads will be permitted at all tournaments. A limited number of factory-loaded shells will be available at prevailing prices. A valid firearms license (PAL or POL) is required to purchase shells at the Calgary Firearms Centre.
- Camping** A limited number of camping spaces are available at \$10.00 per night. Power and water are available at \$15.00 per night, but the number of spaces with this service is limited. Washrooms and showers in the clubhouse will be open on shoot days. Campers please report to the Cashier's Desk. All campsite bookings should be made through cfc@afeia.com or by calling the Calgary Firearms Centre at 403-256-0665.
- Practice Traps** Practice traps will be open during shoots. Practice rounds will be at regular Calgary Firearms Centre rates.
- Shoot Offs** All ties will be shot-off or carried over at the discretion of shoot management. Shooters are responsible for determining whether they are in a shoot-off and for reporting to the shoot-off when called. Shooters who fail to report timely will forfeit.
- Junior Shooters** Junior and Sub-Junior shooters will be exempt from target and trophy fees **provided that they do not play any purse or option in any event.** Junior and Sub-Junior shooters must pay ATA Day Fees and APTA Fees where applicable.
- Straight Pins** The Calgary Firearms Centre will award 100 Straight Pins to shooters scoring 100 in any event or sub-event of that length and 200 Straight Pins to shooters scoring 200 in an event of that length.
- House Guns** The Calgary Firearms Centre has a limited number of shotguns available for use by shooters. To use guns without direct supervision of Calgary Firearms Centre personnel, the user must have a valid firearms license (POL or PAL). Please check with the Cashier for rates.
- Alcohol** Alcohol is restricted to camp shelters or camping areas. Shooters are reminded of ATA rules which prohibit consumption of alcohol or drugs during participation in any event or sub-event or between events or sub-events, including shoot-offs.
- Trophies** Shoot management reserves the right to amend the trophy schedule for any shoot. If changes are made, they will be posted prior to beginning of the first event of the shoot.

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

- Classification will be based on official averages and known ability. In all cases, known ability will have a strong bearing on classification. Shoot management reserves the authority to change the classification of any shooter at any time and the additional authority through proper channels with the ATA to make any yardage change they deem necessary.
- Shooters are required to have their 16-yard and doubles averages computed prior to registration. Shooters who present an average card without all targets recorded and/or without averages being calculated **will not be classified until the card is completed.**
- The following classification table will be used as a basis for all shoots **other than the Provincial Championships and the Western Zone:**

NOTICE TO SPECIAL CLASSIFICATION SHOOTERS

Lady I, Lady II, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Sub Veteran, Junior, Junior Gold and Sub-Junior shooters must declare themselves at the time of classification in order to be eligible for special category trophies, if available. **It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashing for the first event entered.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All tournaments will be governed by the rules of the Amateur Trapshooting Association. Every person who enters a competition agrees to abide by the rules of the Amateur Trapshooting Association **and** the terms of this Program **and** to accept all decisions of shoot management.

PURSES AND OPTIONS

There are no compulsory purses in these tournaments. You may shoot for targets and trophies only or play any purses or options in the program.

Purse One purse (no yardage split) divided 50/30/20% – hi-gun system.

50's Option Three 50's. The first and second 25 target sub-events constitute the first 50, the second and third 25 target sub-events constitute the second 50, and the third and fourth 25 target sub-events constitute the third 50. Entries divided equally into three purses, one for each 50. Each purse divided 50%/30%/20% – percentage system.

Lewis One class per seven shooters entered. A number of entries not evenly divisible by seven will be rounded to the nearest seven for the purpose of establishing the number of classes. Maximum three classes in any event. Total purse divided equally among classes. Each class purse divided 60%/40% – percentage system.

50/50 Club Pots 50/50 Club Pots are made up of three separate 50 straight purses in any 100 target **handicap** event. The first and second 25 target sub-events constitute the first 50, the second and third 25 target sub-events constitute the second 50, and the third and fourth 25 target sub-events constitute the third 50. Entry fee is \$9.00, of which \$3.00 will be added to each purse. Any shooter who plays the 50/50 Club Pots and breaks all of the targets in any 50 will receive 50% of the purse for that 50. If more than one shooter breaks all of the targets in any 50, they will divide the 50%. Club Pots are progressive and will be carried over from one handicap event to the next, from one shoot to the next and from one year to the next. Entry fees paid at a shoot are added to pots after payoffs are calculated for the shoot.

Special Event Proceeds of all bids (less 10% retained by the Club as an administration fee) and shooter entry fee of \$10.00 form the purse. Purse will be divided into one money per seven shooters entered (rounded to the nearest seven) – hi-gun system. Shooter 25%, buyer 75%.



SAFETY

- The practice of tracking targets behind a shooting squad is unsafe, disconcerting to the shooters, and is not permitted.
- A gun, which for any reason fails to fire as intended, must be promptly opened without any subsequent determination by the referee/scorer of the cause of the failure to fire.
- Test shots will not be permitted under any circumstance.
- All guns must have the action opened and contain no live or empty shells at any time, except while the shooter is on the firing line. A break open gun may be closed when it is in a gun rack but it shall not contain a live or empty shell. A gun other than a break open gun must have the action open when it is in a gun rack and it shall not contain a live or empty shell.
- A shooter may place a live shell in his gun only when on a post facing the traps. In singles or handicap a shooter may place only one shell at a time in his gun. In Doubles a contestant may place two shells at a time in his gun. All live and empty shells must be removed from the gun before moving from one post to another. Snap caps or recoil reduction devices may be excluded from the foregoing only if colored a safety orange so as to permanently identify them as not being a live or empty shell. In changing from one post to another, the shooter will not walk in front of the other shooters.
- A shooter must not in any manner interfere with the preceding shooter by raising his/her gun to point or otherwise create an observable distraction.
- Shooters are not permitted to shoot while seated in or otherwise using a golf cart on the firing line. Single passenger conveyances are the appropriate means for participating should one require assistance due to permanent or temporary disability.
- All guns must be equipped, fitted and used so as not to eject empty shells in a manner that substantially disturbs or interferes with other contestants.
- If a flag, orange pylon or stop sign appears on the traphouse, immediately unload your gun and wait until it is removed, indicating ready.
- Do not place your hand or any other part of your body over the muzzle of your gun. The practice of resting the muzzle of a shotgun on a shooter's toe is discouraged.
- Do not point your gun in the direction of any person even though you know the gun is not loaded.
- Only target loads conforming to ATA specifications may be used.
- Each shooter must have his own gun while on the firing line. The practice of sharing a gun on the firing line is dangerous and will not be allowed.

- Protective shooting glasses and ear protection must be worn.
- All empty hulls that hit the ground are the property of the Club.
- All adjustments of the trap machines will be done by authorized personnel only.
- All loading of trap machines will be done by authorized personnel only.
- The Calgary Firearms Centre reserves the right to refuse shooting privileges to any individual possessing faulty firearms and/or ammunition. The Calgary Firearms Centre also reserves the right to expel any individual who, in the opinion of shoot management, disrupts the harmony of a tournament.
- The Calgary Firearms Centre assumes no responsibility for injuries or damages resulting from the use of firearms. The Calgary Firearms Centre assumes no responsibility for the use of faulty firearms or ammunition.
- The Calgary Firearms Centre reserves the right to refuse shooting privileges to individuals who, in the opinion of shoot management, are not in a mental or physical condition to handle a firearm.

APTA LEAGUE

The APTA league will run from the week of May 15, 2022, for six weeks.

There will be five shooters per team. Any shooter may shoot on multiple teams, but must pay a separate league fee for each team.

Each shooter on a team will shoot 25 targets from the 16 yard line for a total of 125 targets. The team's 16 yard total score will determine the team's handicap yardage (refer to the Handicap Chart below). Each shooter on a team will then shoot 25 targets from the team's handicap yardage for a total of 125 targets. Handicap yardage is only valid for one week, will be re-established each week based on the team's 16 yard total score for that week and, where a shooter is absent, the score of the spare or the absent shooter's previous week's score will be used.

If a team is participating in another league with the same structure as the APTA league (i.e. at least 125 targets from 16 yards and at least 125 handicap targets shot from a handicap yardage that is the same as if determined using the Handicap Chart below), the team can submit the scores from the other league. If the other league is more than one round of singles and one round of handicap per week, the scores from the first round of singles and the first round of handicap are the scores that will be submitted to the APTA league. Any shooter shooting on multiple teams in the APTA league can submit the same scores for all teams.

A spare can be used if a shooter is unable to attend one or more weeks. Alternatively, a team may submit the absent shooter's 16 yard score and handicap score from the previous week, with a penalty of two targets deducted from the total.

The league fee will be \$20/shooter, for a total of \$100/team.

After three weeks of shooting the league will split into an "A" and "B" side based on total team scores for the first three weeks. Team standings at the end of the league will be based on total team scores for all six weeks of the league. The winning team from the "A" side and the "B" side will each win five cases of shells. Ties will be decided by a count-back to scores from previous weeks. All remaining teams will be put into a random draw to win five cases of shells. If there is larger participation than anticipated, APTA will consider adding additional awards.



Shells	Reloads will be permitted at this tournament. A limited number of factory loaded shells will be available at prevailing prices. A valid firearms license (PAL or POL) is required to purchase shells at the Calgary Firearms Centre.

Any unresolved carry-overs after Event 8 and any ties in Event 8 will be resolved by shoot-off at the conclusion of the Doubles Championship on Sunday. Doubles shoot-offs will be on 10 pair until a winner is determined.</p>

Shooting Order and 10 Per Post	<p>For all Singles and Handicap events, shoot management reserves the right to require each shooter to take 50 shells to the line, shoot 5 per post, then immediately return to the original starting position <i>without leaving the line</i> and immediately start shooting the second round. If this becomes necessary, violators of this procedure will be considered to be disrupting the tournament and may be disqualified at the discretion of shoot management.</p> <p><i>Shoot management reserves the right to change the shooting order to 10 per post.</i> If this becomes necessary, an announcement will be made and notices will be posted. Please refer to the ATA Rulebook regarding all rights in this regard.</p>
Pre-squadding	<p>Pre-squads for Events 1-5 must be cashied or released at least one hour before the scheduled start time for the event. Pre-squads for Events 6-10 must be cashied or released by 4 p.m. of the day prior to the event. Pre-squads not cashied or released by the deadline will be cancelled and opened to all shooters.</p> <p>There will be a \$20 per event re-squadding fee for any shooter who holds a position for any of these events and does not cashier it or release it prior to the time required above. SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY

Be Ready to Shoot **Squads will not be allowed to wait for tardy members.** Shooters will have 3 minutes to take the line once their squad is called.


A shooter who misses the first post in any event may make up that post only and continue with the squad. Once the lead-off shooter has fired the first shot from the second post, shooters will not be allowed to join the squad until the next sub-event. Shooters will not be allowed to join their squad after the second sub-event. **Shooters who miss two sub-events must either forfeit or re-squad for the event and pay a \$20 re-squadding fee.**

Make-ups All make-ups will be shot at the make-up trap. Shooters must report to the make-up trap within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the event. Shooters will not be paged or searched for. Failure to report to the make-up trap timely will result in the shooter forfeiting that event. **No shooter will be allowed to make-up more than 50 targets on the make-up trap. Shooters who miss more than 50 targets with their squad will be required to re-squad for that event. A \$20 re-squadding fee will apply.**

Gun Breakdowns In case of a gun breakdown, the shooter will be allowed 5 minutes for repair or replacement. Have your tools and parts or a spare shotgun with you if you are at all concerned about this possibility. Your squad will not be allowed to wait more than 5 minutes for you. There will be no exceptions. If you cannot rejoin your squad in this time frame, you will have to make-up your remaining targets on the make-up trap. Please note that no shooter will be allowed to make-up more than 50 targets on the make-up trap. **Shooters who miss more than 50 targets with their squad will be required to re-squad for that event. A \$20 re-squadding fee will apply.**

Check Your Scores Check your scores before leaving each post and at the end of each sub-event. Any changes to scores may only be made in strict accordance with ATA rules.

Earned Yardage Shooters earning yardage in any Handicap event must report to the Classification Desk to have your Average Card punched.

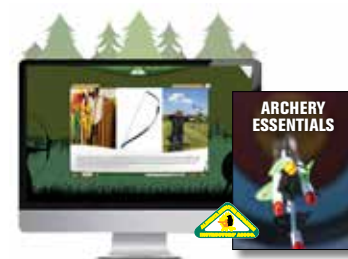

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

Classification will be based on known ability. Known ability will be based on official averages, non-registered scores and any other information bearing on a shooter's ability to shoot and break targets. Shooters are required to have their 16-yard and Doubles averages computed prior to registration. Shooters who present an average card without all targets recorded and/or without averages being calculated **will not be classified until the card is completed or may be assigned to a class or yardage at the discretion of the classifier.**

Shoot management reserves the right to review all scores in any Singles or Doubles event on Day One and Day Two of this tournament for classification purposes. Shooters under review may be moved to a higher class at the discretion of shoot management. Classification changes made during the shoot will be posted in the score board area and will be considered official when posted.

A shooter will shoot his/her ATA or PITA yardage, whichever is the longest. However, if the shooter has not shot PITA targets in the current or preceding ATA target year and has been granted a reduction after an ATA 1000 target review, the shooter will shoot from his/her ATA yardage.

PENALTY CLASSIFICATION AND YARDAGE:

- Singles** A shooter who has less than 1000 total 16-yard targets registered with the ATA and PITA combined for the current and previous two years will be assigned to "B" Class or higher at the discretion of the classifier.
- Doubles** A shooter who has less than 500 total Doubles targets registered with the ATA and PITA combined for the current and previous two years will be assigned to "B" Class or higher at the discretion of the classifier.
- Handicap** Shooters who do have a total of 1,000 Handicap targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous two target years will be assigned to the 23 yard line or the regular Handicap yardage, whichever is greater. Handicap target requirements will be waived for Sub-Juniors and shooters age 70 and over.

CLASSIFICATION CHANGES:

Shooters winning or tying for class in events 1, 3, 4 or 5 will advance at least one class. Subject to penalty classification, the following classification table will be used as a basis for this tournament:

CANADIAN CLASSIFICATION:

Only Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents of Canada are allowed to compete for "Closed" trophies.

NOTICE TO SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

Lady, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior Gold, Junior and Sub-Junior shooters must declare their special category at the time of classification in order to be eligible for special category trophies. **It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashing for the first event entered.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

This tournament will be governed by the rules of the Amateur Trapshooting Association. Every person who enters the competition agrees to abide by the rules of the Amateur Trapshooting Association **and** the terms of this Program **and** to accept all decisions of shoot management.

SAFETY

CANADA CAP CHALLENGE PURSE RULES

1. No entry fee.
2. Purse cash prize: \$5000 (as of January 25, 2022).
3. Shooters must shoot the July 1st "Clarence Durr Handicap" event to be eligible.
4. The top 5 scores from each ATA Province or Territory in the July 1st Preliminary Handicap event will determine the Provincial 5 Man Team.
5. Shooters will represent the ATA Province they reside in. The only exception is in the event that 2 or more ATA Provinces, or Territories, do not individually have 5 shooters in attendance. These shooters will be declared Team Canada and follow the standard team selection process outlined in these rules.
6. The winning Provincial 5 Man Team will be declared the Canada Cap Challenge Champions and reserve all bragging rights associated with the title.
7. The winning Provincial 5 Man Team will split the Canada Cap Challenge Purse evenly between team members.
8. Ties for Provincial 5 Man Team member selection and/or the main Canada Cap Challenge purse prize will be determined by carry-over to the Canadian Handicap Championship event.

11. Ties between Provincial 5 Man Teams will be settled using the combined team score per sub event (25 targets) during the Canadian Handicap Championship event.
12. Should a tie still exist upon the completion of the Canadian Handicap Championship event, a shoot-off will be held until a winning team is determined.


